

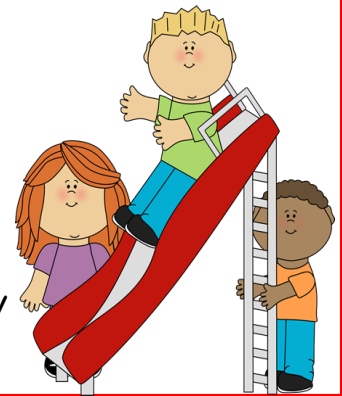


## Newsletter: 9th June 2017
