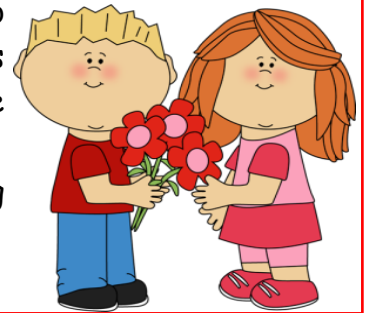




## Newsletter: 10th November 2017
